CITY-WIDE CLEAN-UP DAYS 2022 DO NOT ACCEPT LIST

Items NOT allowed by the City and Waste Management to be included in regular Clean-Up Day containers include:

- Refrigerant-bearing household appliances (refrigerators, dehumidifiers, window air conditioners, wine chillers, etc.)
- Household hazardous waste (gasoline, solvents, pesticides, motor oil, pool chemicals, paint thinner, paint, etc.)
- Medical waste
- Mercury containing devices (thermostats, thermometers, etc.)
- · Electronics (including computers, TVs and monitors)
- · Yard waste and root balls
- Sod, rocks, dirt or concrete
- Batteries
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Tires
- Liquids and gases (propane tanks, fire extinguishers, etc.)
- Contractor construction debris (doors, windows, large amounts of lumber, masonry products, drywall, siding, roofing, water heaters, etc.)
- Propane tanks or equipment
- · Burnt material/ashes of any kind
- Railroad ties
- Animals/carcasses
